Define Problem Precisely State Statute 86.06(1) requires that barriers used to close a highway during construction or repair work shall be lighted at night. This statute dates back decades, prior to improvements to reflective sign and barricade materials that make it unnecessary to light the barriers. Signs and barricades constructed with reflective materials reflect light from vehicle headlights back to the driver's eyes to allow for ample visibility of the barriers. As a result, WisDOT and national practices no longer require barricades to be lighted at night. A court case in 2005 reversed a judgment for a traffic violation because the road closure barricades were not lighted.			
Description of Proposed Change Revise 86.06(1), Wis. Stats., to state that barriers used to close a highway shall be retroreflective or lighted at night. This revision will clarify that retroreflective barriers meet the nighttime visibility requirements, even if they are not lighted.			
Justification for Change The Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), which is adopted for use in Wisconsin, requires barricades to be retroreflective and Road Closed signs used at night to be either retroreflective or illuminated. This statute change would provide for consistency with the MUTCD.

1 AN ACT ^{Gen} to amend 62.15 (11) and 86.06 (1) of the statutes; relating to: road
2 closure barriers.✓

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, during construction or repair of a road or when a road is impassable or unsafe for travel, the highway authorities in charge of construction or maintenance of the road may close the road by maintaining barriers at each end of the closed road.✓ The barriers must be of such material and construction and so placed as to indicate that the highway is closed and must be lighted at night. This bill allows road closure barriers, in lieu of being lighted at night, to be of a retroreflective material or markings so as to be visible at night.✓

Also under current law, contractors doing work that obstructs city streets or sidewalks must put up and maintain barriers and lights to prevent accidents. This bill allows these contractors to put up and maintain barriers constructed of such retroreflective material or bearing such markings as to be visible at night, in lieu of barriers and lights.✓

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 62.15 (11)[✓] of the statutes is amended to read:
4 62.15 (11) STREET OBSTRUCTION. All contractors doing any work which shall in
5 any manner obstruct the streets or sidewalks shall put up and maintain barriers and
