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

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

"SECTION 36k. 49.155 (3m) (e) 1. of the statutes, as created by 2009 Wisconsin

Act 28, is repealed.

SECTION 361. 49.155 (3m) (e) 2. of the statutes, as created by 2009 Wisconsin Act 28, is renumbered 49.155 (3m) (e) and amended to read:

49.155 (3m) (e) No funds distributed under par. (a) may be used for child care services that are provided for a child by a child care provider who employs either the parent of the child or a person who resides with the child, unless the child care provider is licensed under s. 48.65 and at all times at least 60 percent of the children for whom the child care provider is providing care are qualifying children.

SECTION 36rg. 49.155 (3m) (e) 3. of the statutes, as created by 2009 Wisconsin Act 28, is repealed.". 2 2.
