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


Hi Pam,

There is talk that AB 462 may come up on the Assembly Floor today even though it was not placed on the calendar. I am requesting one more amendment now, and there may be one more to follow that, but the request will come when I've finished talking to Anne Sappenfield.

Here is the first amendment request:

With respect to the swipecard system for which language was placed in the budget, Rep. Vos would like to craft an amendment that directs the department to implement a system that is more stringent than the language that currently exists.

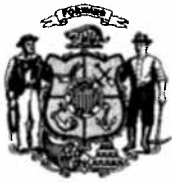
Because there has been concern that swipecards will either be passed from child to child or simply kept at childcare centers and used to validate attendance of a Shares child even when they might not be present, Rep. Vos would like to direct the DCF to implement a swipecard system that either also has their FoodShare Benefits on the card (so that there will be less of a chance that people will leave them at the childcare center) or that they simply choose to implement a fingerprinting system instead of swipecard. The choice is up to DCF to do what they find more prudent. But in either case, the implementation of this system must be done by July 1 2010.

- 2 1. Page 2, line 2: after "provided" insert "; certain requirements for the
- 3 Wisconsin Shares swipe card system;"
- 4 2. Page 23, line 23: after that line insert:
- 5 "SECTION 39m. Nonstatutory provisions.
- 6 (1) SWIPE CARD SYSTEM.
- 7 (a) Notwithstanding 2009 Wisconsin Act 28, section 9108 (9k), the department
- 8 of children and families shall, no later than July 1, 2010, implement a program for
- 9 recording and monitoring attendance under the child care subsidy program under
- 10 section 49.155 of the statutes that does either of the following
- 11 1. Uses a fingerprinting system instead of a swipe card system.

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1 2. To the extent permitted under federal law, uses a swipe card system that
2 combines benefits under the child care subsidy program under section 49.155 of the
3 statutes with the delivery of food stamp benefits under section 49.797 of the statutes
4 on a single card.

5 (b) If the department of children and families determines that the swipe card
6 system under paragraph (a) 2. would be more efficient and effective, the department
7 of health services shall cooperate with and assist the department of children and
8 families in implementing the sytem.”.

9 **3.** Page 24, line 1: delete “This act” and substitute “Except for SECTION 39m of
10 this act, this act”.

11 **4.** Page 24, line 13: after that line insert:

12 “(2) SWIPE CARD SYSTEM. SECTION 39m of this act takes effect on the day after
13 publication.”.
