Subject: Amendment for Federal Changes Bill (AB 486/SB 347)

#### Hi Gordon,

Kimmie spoke with Jauch's office and they agreed to an amendment to the Federal Changes bill regarding the provision for the 90-day Independent Living Plan under the Fostering Connections Act (section 76 of the bill): We are concerned that the new statutory language would not adequately mimic that of the federal language. The new language might actually be contrary to the federal requirement. The federal requirement is that the IL plan be implemented between the timeframe of 90 days prior to the child aging out of care and the date of the child aging out of care. The bill language would require the IL plan to be implemented prior to 90 days before the child ages out. While from a policy perspective it would make sense for a case worker to begin the process of creating the plan prior to the 90 day start time, we need something in statute to assure compliance with federal law that the plan will be reviewed or implemented after that time frame.

## Here's the federal language:

"(H) during the 90-day period immediately prior to the date on which the child will attain 18 years of age, or such greater age as the State may elect under paragraph

(8)(B)(iii), whether during that period foster care maintenance payments are being made on the child's behalf or the child is

receiving benefits or services under section

477, a caseworker on the staff of the State agency, and, as appropriate, other representatives of the child provide the child with assistance and support in developing a transition plan that is personalized at the direction of the child, includes specific options on housing, health insurance, education, local opportunities for mentors and continuing support services, and work force supports and employment services, and is as detailed as the child may elect."

Kimmie, these are the statutory provisions for which the effective date needs to be changed. Both were created in the budget bill, 2009 Act 28. Both deal with the pass-through of child support for former assistance recipients. The effective date for s.49.776 is in section 9422(12) of that bill. The effective date for s. 49.1452 is in s. 9408(14). It's my understanding that the Bureau of Child Support would like to see the effective date changed to April 1, 2010 which is the date the changes required to implement the pass-through for current assistance recipients.
