ADVISORY REFERENDUM QUESTION:

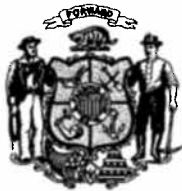
Shall the State of Wisconsin grant Milwaukee County the authority to provide property tax relief of at least sixty-seven million dollars (\$67 million) by levying a one percent (1%) county sales and use tax to be used to remove the following three items from the property tax levy: parks recreation culture, transit and emergency medical services (EMS)?

We would like to introduce a bill to this effect, for the most part. Something to the effect of the following:

The State of Wisconsin shall grant Milwaukee County the authority to provide property tax relief of at least sixty-seven million dollars (\$67 million) by levying up to a one percent (1%) county sales and use tax to be used to remove the following items from the property tax levy: parks, recreation, and culture.

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: a Milwaukee County sales and use tax for parks and
2 recreation, transit, and emergency medical services. ✓

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county may impose a sales and use tax at the rate of 0.5 percent of the sales price of tangible personal property, goods, and services sold or used in the county. The county sales and use tax may be imposed only for the purpose of reducing the county's property tax levy. ✓

Under the bill, Milwaukee County may impose an additional sales and use tax at the rate of one percent of the sales price of tangible personal property, goods, and services sold or used in the county in order to pay for parks and recreation, transit, and emergency medical services. ✓ If the county imposes the tax, it may not levy property taxes for such purposes. ✓

For further information see the **state and local** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 77.70^{✓^} (2) of the statutes is created to read:
4 77.70 (2) In addition to the taxes imposed under sub. (1), Milwaukee County
5 may adopt an ordinance to impose a sales and use tax under this subchapter ✓ at the

BILL**SECTION 1**

1 rate of 1 percent of the sales price or purchase price in order to pay for parks and
2 recreation, transit, and emergency medical services. The taxes may be imposed only
3 in their entirety. If Milwaukee County imposes the taxes under this subsection, it
4 shall not levy property taxes to pay for parks and recreation, transit, and emergency
5 medical services. An ordinance adopted under this subsection shall be effective on
6 January 1, April 1, July 1, or October 1. A certified copy of the ordinance shall be
7 delivered to the secretary of revenue at least 120 days prior to its effective date. The
8 repeal of any such ordinance shall be effective on December 31. A certified copy of
9 a repeal ordinance shall be delivered to the secretary of revenue at least 120 days
10 before the effective date of the repeal.

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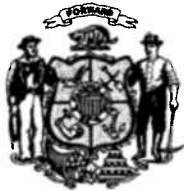
