Hi Aaron,

Could you please draft a bill to do the following:

1. Eliminate the current requirement in 84.02(5)(b) which directs DOT to automatically distribute 50 state highway service maps to each officer and member of the legislature.

Eliminate the current requirement in 84.02(5)(c) which directs DOT to automatically distribute 500 folded highway maps to each officer and member of the legislature and 300 of these maps to the Legislative Reference Bureau.

3. Reduce the blue book distributions listed in column E of Figure 35.84 by 50% for the Constitutional Officers and Legislature (lines 1-20). For odd number distributions, reduce to the lower of the two closest round numbers (e.g., 7 would be reduced to 3). Maintain current law for the Judiciary (lines 30-37).

I don't know if this helps, and there's likely a better approach, but here's basically what we're striving for in provisions 1 and 2 above:

**84.02(5)(b)** Upon publication of the highway service maps, the department shall distribute without charge 50 of these maps to each officer and member of the legislature. Agny officer or member of the legislature may request additional highway service these maps. The request may be written or oral. The fee for the additional maps shall be the fee set by the department under par. (a).



## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must publish highway service maps showing the state trunk highway system. DOT determines the price at which these highway service maps are sold. DOT must also publish, once every two years, folded highway maps for free distribution to the public. Upon their publication, DOT must distribute for free 50 highway service maps and 500 folded highway maps to each officer and member of the legislature. These officers and members of the legislature may request additional highway service maps at the regularly established price and additional folded highway maps for free. DOT must also distribute to the Legislative Reference Bureau (LRB) 300 folded highway maps.

This bill eliminates the requirement that DOT distribute, for free, highway service maps to officers and members of the legislature and folded highway maps to officers and members of the legislature and the LRB. Officers and members of the legislature may still request highway service maps at the regularly established price and folded highway maps for free.

Current law requires the Department of Administration to distribute to constitutional officers and the legislature a specified number of Blue Books published by the LRB. This bill reduces the number of Blue Books required to be distributed by approximately 50 percent.

These officers and members of the legislature may request additional highway service maps at the regularly established price and additional folded highway maps for free. DOT must also distribute to the Legislative Reference Bureau 1000 folded highway maps.

This bill eliminates the requirement that DOT distribute, for free, highway service maps to officers and members of the legislature and folded highway maps to officers and members of the legislature and the LRB. Officers and members of the legislature may still request highway service maps at the regularly established price and folded highway maps for free.

The bill also reduces the DOT appropriation for printing and distributing highway maps and transfers the amount of this reduction from the transportation fund to the general fund.

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) must publish highway service maps showing the state trunk highway system. DOT determines the price at which these highway service maps are sold. DOT must also publish, once every two years, folded highway maps for free distribution to the public. Upon their publication, DOT must distribute for free 50 highway service maps and 500 folded highway maps to each officer and member of the legislature. These officers and members of the legislature may request additional highway service maps at the regularly established price and additional folded highway maps for free.
