Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

OCI is not able to determine the local fiscal effect AB 640. OCI does not collect information to determine the number of county housing authorities eligible to participate in local government self-insured health plans. Additionally, OCI does not collect information regarding the number of county housing authorities that currently offer health insurance. OCI does not have the information that would indicate if a county housing authority would begin offering health benefits as a result of passage of AB 640 or if housing authorities may switch to self-funding as a result of the passage of the bill. Other information that would be necessary, such as the number of employees involved and the current level of health care spending, is also not collected by OCI.
