Following are the changes agreed upon with the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance and Cooperative Network's member Group Health Cooperative of South Central Wisconsin. OCI agreed that these amendments will eliminate the concerns voiced by OCI and the Wisconsin Council of Life Insurers. The changes were intended to be included in your first draft but were not submitted by OCI due to an internal agency communications error.

Cooperative Network hopes that you are willing to amend the current draft to alleviate any potential confusion about the intent of the bill.

These instructions are based on LRB 3593/2.

- ∠Page 7, line 19 restore the struck out language "but any such association".
- Page 8, line 3 insert "(b) A cooperative association may make a payment in cash, indemnity or other material benefit for a purpose that is incidental to its plan, including for the purpose of administration of coordination of benefits."
- ▶Page 11, line 11 insert, "The cooperative association is subject to s. 611.26, 623.11, and 623.12 and ch. 620."


