Requiring suspected drug activity on the part of a caregiver or nonclient resident of a child care provider to be reported to an immediate supervisor and to the sheriff and suspected or threatened child abuse or neglect on the part of such an individual to be reported under the child abuse and neglect reporting law and providing a penalty

## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Prosecutors anticipate enactment of this bill will increase the number of people who are responsible for reporting suspected or threatened child abuse or suspected drug activity on the part of a caregiver. The increase of reporters will increase the workload of prosecutors, but it is difficult to quanitfy because current reporting responsibilities are not tracked.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

In the long-term, prosecutors anticipate an increase in their workload upon enactment of this bill.
