



We would like to make a couple more changes to the Vets Board district bill.

First, on pg 2, ln 16, we'd like to insert the word "already" after the word "is". Do you think this change is necessary? We would like to make it clear that only members of the board who have been confirmed for their current terms will not be affected.

Also, we would like to add some language about changes to the districts in the future. We would like to require that the Legislative Audit Bureau review the veterans populations of each district every ten years, starting ten years from the date of enactment. If the veterans' population of any district deviates by more than 10% of an equal distribution in either direction, the GIS section of LTSB would redraw the districts to re-equalize them. LTSB's instructions would be to make them as equal as possible, subject to the constraint that, like the current bill, the district be composed of whole counties and also that the counties be contiguous.

I hope these instructions are clear. Please call if you have any questions.




