## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates the Office of the Small Business Advocate within the Department of Commerce and requires Commerce to staff the office with at least 1.0 FTE. The responsibilities of the office are as follows:

- 1. Investigate state agency enforcement actions against small businesses and prepare recommendations regarding alternative penalties that will achieve regulatory compliance.
- 2. Communicate with agency small business regulatory coordinators regarding enforcement actions.
- 3. Analyze and evaluate information regarding enforcement actions to determine regulatory enforcement trends and the efficacy of the office in providing regulatory relief to and promoting regulatory compliance by small businesses.
- 4. Annually report these findings to the governor and the legislature.
- 5. Provide staff assistance to the small business environmental council.
- 6. Facilitate the flow of information between state and federal agencies and business and industry.
- 7. Assist state agencies in including small businesses in the rule-making process.
- 8. Serve as ombudsman for stationary sources under the clean air act.
- 9. Staff the small business regulatory review board.

Commerce will require 1.0 FTE to perform these responsibilities. The position will have the following costs:

Salary -- \$44,900 Fringe -- \$20,500 Supplies -- \$8,000

TOTAL -- \$73,400
