Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2009 Assembly Bill 785 authorizes the Department of Justice to create a network that provides law enforcement agencies the ability to notify other agencies and private entities of criminal activity and missing or endangered persons. The network will be supported on an on-going basis through annual fees paid by members of the network.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Once implemented, the Department of Justice anticipates that up to approximately 10,000 entities will sign up to the system. The department anticipates that Program Revenue from fees authorized by the bill will be able to cover the ongoing annual cost of maintaining and administering the program, which is expected to be \$125,000.
