Below are the drafting instructions we sent to Jeff Kuesel per the election reform bill.

Drafting Instructions for Sub

1. Expand the relating clause to explicitly describe each provision of the bill

Add Rep. Berceau's bill, AB 892, with her introduced simple amendment

3. Allow GAB to share information with Pew's proposed national database (not officially online, but would be called "ERIC") "GAB may enter into agreements with . . . as it sees necessary to facilitate registration of eligible electors".

M64. Allow, if applicable, sharing of information received by GAB from DOT to ERIC

5. On pg. 16, move #7 so it doesn't trigger private cause of action suits (i.e., prevent frivolous claims relating to election equipment)

M66. Allow DOT to get name history (currently allowed to get address history), and also authorize them to verify information as GAB is authorized to do

7. Direct GAB to set up an automatic notification system for eligible electors when their information is awaiting confirmation.

8. Changes to the permanent absentee provision

- a. Direct GAB to provide a report for how we can minimize postal expenses and offer ballot recommendations to clerks; Due to legislature by January 1, 2010
- b. Require clerks to remove people from lists if they miss two consecutive elections, rather than one

9. Put application and certificate statement on in-person absentee ballot envelope and require clerk initial

10. Remove hardship request language on pg. 70 (We are holding this drafting request until I have spoken to Kevin Kennedy)

11. Amend language of pg. 71 regarding the instructions the Board must provide "method by which the state will" instead of "timeline used by this state for the absentee voting process and the feasibility of making

adjustments to". This will have the effect of requiring the state to comply with the federal MOVE act requiring ballots be sent out 45 days in advance. Ultimately, the legislature will have to move the date of the fall primary back. Since hardship waivers will only be granted for the 2010 election, this is a necessary change.

- 12. pg. 21, allow requests to be received by Dec. 31st of year instead of calendar year. This allows more opportunities for overseas voters to vote.
- 13. Require proof of residence for first time registrants who are registering and requesting absentee ballots in person (This fixes the current "gap" that moving the start of in-person absentee to 21 days creates).
 - 14. Allow Election Day workers to come from the county (We are verifying with Rep. Kessler that there doesn't need to be an exemption for counties with over 500,000 population to be from aldermanic *districts).
- 15. Require election day challengers be from the county (We are verifying with Rep. Kessler that he is OK) with an exemption for) apply strikeride. Exemption in 1st dass (if the challenger with be a visitlent of some placerum destruct as challenged elector. √ 16. Any expenditure under this bill will be subject to 13.10 JFC 14 day passive review
 - 17. Add technical colleges to list of agencies that GAB will explore data sharing with
- 18. On pg. 13 lines 15 and 18, need to add "The Board shall. . ."
- 19. On pg. 25, line 12 add "or clerk" to allow people to opt-out at clerk's office as well as with GAB; line 13 change to "in"
- 20. Require DMV to ask people if they want info used to register and provide opt-out opportunity

We are also considering adding a statutory change to 20.511 (1) (b) to allow municipalities reimbursement for costs associated with permanent mail-in absentee ballots, with a possible specified amount carved out for that purpose.

Fred,

I have spoken to Adam in Sen. Coggs office, who had a conversation with Sue Edman regarding a couple of changes to the election reform bill. I've touched base with you on these items, but I just wanted to verify that you are OK with these changes.

First, we are going to add a provision regarding residency of Election Day officials to allow them to come from the county, which would expand current law that says that they must reside from the election ward or district. We had originally discussed an exemption for Milwaukee, but when Adam spoke to Sue, it sounded like she would like that flexibility in Milwaukee as well. Based on conversations I and Sen. Coggs have had with you, we understand that you are comfortable including a provision in this bill to allow election day officials to come from the county in which they reside, without any exemptions.

Second, the bill currently includes a provision regarding the residency of Election Day challengers. As is written, Election Day challengers must come from the ward or district in which the challenge is being made, with an exemption provided for populations under 2,500. Again, it is my understanding that you are comfortable expanding this to counties, and removing the 2,500 exemption since it would no longer have applicability, but including an exemption for the City of Milwaukee in which challengers would have to be from aldermanic districts.

Please let me know if you have problems with these changes.
