<b>Description</b> Establishment of a Wisconsin conservation corps program, extending the time limit for emergency rule procedures, providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures, granting rule-making authority, and making appropriations							

#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The bill creates a Wisconsin conservation corps (WCC) program as well as a WCC Board to act as the policy-making body of the WCC.

#### Fiscal Impact

The bill identifies the Secretary of the Department, or his or her designee, as a member of the WCC Board; therefore, the Department will allocate an indeterminate amount of staff time to coincide with these Board responsibilities.

In addition, beginning in FY 2011, the bill provides \$250,000 from the conservation fund to a Department of Administration appropriation for the general program operations of the WCC and for payment of grants to assist with the training of WCC work crews. As a result there is no worksheet fiscal impact on DNR, only DOA.
