Please review the attached draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent. In particular, please verify that the route described in the draft is accurate. The following are a few notes regarding your draft.

1. I added a brief explanation of the designation reading, "in recognition of the key role the former route of USH 41 played in the commerce of the city of Milwaukee." Dedicated highways in the statutes, for the most part, contain a brief explanation of the designation. The material in your joint resolution draft was fairly lengthy, so I extracted what I believe is the major theme of the draft. Please let me know if you would like a different explanatory statement or if you would like to omit any explanation.

2. Please note that, pursuant to your instructions, this draft includes the provision that no state funds be used to erect or maintain any markers. Therefore, the actual memorialization will not take place until sufficient funds are contributed to cover these expenses. You may wish to contact DOT for more information regarding the actual costs and process of placing memorial signage.

Please let me know if you would like any changes made to the attached draft or if you have any questions. If the attached draft meets with your approval, let me know and I will convert it to an introducible "/1" draft.
