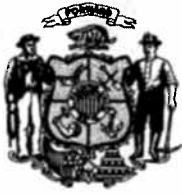

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: discharging a firearm within 100 yards of a building
2 devoted to human occupancy while in waters adjacent to land owned by another
3 person, and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may, while on the land of another, discharge a firearm within 100 yards of any building devoted to human occupancy situated on the land without the express permission of the owner or occupant of the building. Anyone who does so is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and may be fined not more than \$10,000, imprisoned for not more than nine months, or both.

*

Under this bill, no person may, while on the land of another or in waters adjacent to the land of another, discharge a firearm within 100 yards of any building devoted to human occupancy situated on the land without the express permission of the owner or occupant of the building.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report concerning the proposed penalty and the costs or savings that are likely to result if the bill is enacted.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

BILL

1 **SECTION 1.** 941.20 (1) (d)[✓] of the statutes is amended to read:

2 941.20 (1) (d) While on the lands or in waters adjacent to the lands[✓] of another
3 discharges a firearm within 100 yards of any building devoted to human occupancy
4 situated on and attached to the lands of another without the express permission of
5 the owner or occupant of the building. "Building" as used in this paragraph does not
6 include any tent, bus, truck, vehicle or similar portable unit.
