1 **AN ACT** *to create* 13.38 of the statutes; **relating to:** the advice and consent of
2 the senate for appointments.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill codifies the senate rule related to the advice and consent of the senate for appointment nominations submitted to the senate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 13.38 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **13.38 Advice and consent of the senate. (1)** Whenever a nomination for
5 an appointment is submitted to the senate, as required by law, the president of the
6 senate shall refer the nomination to the standing committee that the president
7 deems to be the most appropriate committee to pass upon the qualifications of the
8 candidate. The committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the
9 senate in writing. Nominations may be considered, and the persons so nominated
