Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, for the purposes of the Development Opportunity Zone Credit and the Economic Development Credit a member of a targeted group includes an economically disadvantaged veteran. Under this bill, the definition of a member of a targeted group is expanded to include a person who has served under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces or in forces incorporated as part of the U.S. armed forces for at least one year or, if the active duty service was less than one year, who was honorably discharged for a service—connected disability, for a disability subsequently adjudicated to be a service—connected disability, for reasons of hardship, or due to a reduction in the U.S. armed forces.

Fiscal Estimate

The bill is expected to have minimal impact on state revenues.
