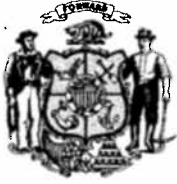

9 This proposal is introduced under section 111.92 (1) of the statutes. The
 proposal ratifies the collective bargaining contract for state employees in the
 program, project, and teaching assistants of the University of Wisconsin-Madison
 and University of Wisconsin-Extension collective bargaining unit negotiated for the
 2007-~~09~~¹¹ biennium under the State Employment Labor Relations Act. Currently,
 statutory program supplement appropriations fund the costs of collective bargaining
 agreements to the extent that they exceed budgeted costs. The proposal authorizes
 expenditure of moneys from those appropriations to fund the cost of this agreement.

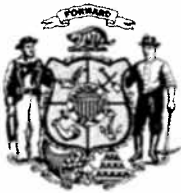

SECTION 2. Effective date.

18 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those
19 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
20 covering employees in the program, project, and teaching assistants of the
21 University of Wisconsin-Madison and University of Wisconsin-Extension collective
22 bargaining unit are effective on the dates provided in that agreement.✓

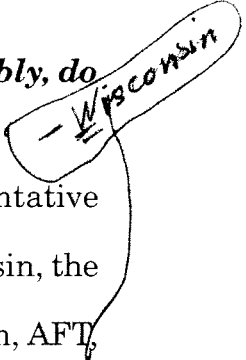
