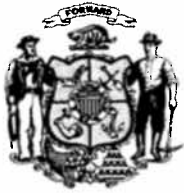

SECTION 1

1 **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative
 2 agreement negotiated for the 2009-11 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the
 3 office of state employment relations, and the Professional Employees in Research,
 4 Statistics, and Analysis, ~~WFTA~~AFT, AFL-CIO, covering employees in the
 5 professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit under
 6 subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the
 7 professional research, statistics, and analysis collective bargaining unit and
 8 approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment relations, and
 9 authorizes the necessary expenditure of moneys for implementation from the
 10 appropriations made by section 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865
 11 (intro.) of the statutes. The director of the office of state employment relations shall
 12 file an official copy of the agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint
 13 committee on employment relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or
 14 informal agreement between the parties that is not a part of the official copy is
 15 deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.

SECTION 2. Effective date.

 17 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those
 18 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement
 19 covering employees in the professional research, statistics, and analysis collective
 20 bargaining unit are effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
