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

PROPOSED JOINT RULE

- (1) There is created a Joint Economic Stimulus Accountability Committee, consisting of five members from each house. Three members each shall be appointed by the Speaker and Senate Majority leader, and two members each shall be appointed by the Assembly and Senate minority leaders.
- (2) No bill to appropriate funds received through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), or any similar or successor federal legislation signed into law prior to June 30, 2009, shall receive a vote in either house unless the Joint Committee has first held a public hearing on the bill and issued a report containing the following information:
 - (a) a statement whether, in the committee's judgment, the project(s) for which the funds are expended is/are an appropriate use of public funds,
 - (b) the amount, if any, that the proposed expenditure will increase the state's structural deficit,
 - (c) that proper safeguards are in the bill to prevent any funds from being paid to an individual or entity with outstanding obligations to the state.
- (3) The Joint Committee shall be disbanded 90 days after all federal funds received under ARRA have been appropriated.
