

FRANK H. "HANK" URBAN M.D.

Urban, Frank H., M.D. "Hank" Age 78 of Brookfield, WI, died October 25, 2008 while traveling in Egypt with his wife, Kathryn Bloomberg. Hank was the father of seven, step-father of four and proud grandparent to twenty grandchildren and eight step - grandchildren. Born on May 24, 1930, to Franz and Helen Urban in Websters Grove, MO, Hank's family moved to Green Bay, WI in 1944. A 1947 graduate of Green Bay East High School, Hank attended UW-Madison, where he completed his undergraduate degree in 1950 and his medical degree in 1954. It was during medical school that nurse Lois Thurwachter, also a UW-Madison graduate, taught him how to start an I.V. They fell in love and were married in June 1954 in Waukesha, WI. Hank completed his residency in dermatology at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN after serving as a US Army Officer in Panama from 1954-'57. Hank and Lois then raised seven children in Elm Grove, WI: six sons and one daughter. They were married for 37 years, until her death in 1991. Hank was a sole practitioner dermatologist in Wauwatosa, WI for thirty-one years. He held various leadership positions in medicine, including President of the Milwaukee County Medical Society and Wisconsin Dermatologic Society. As well, Hank held a number of leadership positions with the Boy Scouts of America, including President of the Potawatomi Area Council. Hank served in the Wisconsin State Assembly for 13 years, following a special election in 1989. Prior to his election to the state legislature, he was both an Elm Grove Village Trustee and Village President. Through his public service, he met Mayor of Brookfield Kathryn Bloomberg, who he married in Brookfield in 1992. They lead an exciting and adventurous life together filled with family, philanthropy and travel. Though she has many, Hank was Kate's most devoted fan. He loved her dearly. Hank's story would be incomplete without mentioning that he was a man of many interests. He was a train enthusiast, history buff, voracious reader, faithful Badger fan and strong supporter of the arts. Of all his interests, his most passionate was the Green Bay Packers. Hank and his oldest son, Jim, attended the Ice Bowl in 1968 and he proudly cheered on the Green and Gold at Super Bowls II, XXXI and XXXII. Hank was known as the "Patriarch" of Buddyfest-an annual reunion with his sons during which they celebrated Packers football. As well, Hank was a finalist for the Packers Fan Hall of Fame in 2003. Hank made the world a better place and left a strong legacy. In addition to his wife, Kate, he is survived by his brother, James (Roberta) of Scottsdale, AZ. He is the loving father of James (Sharon) of Wheaton, IL; Barbara (Donald) Morell of Menomonee Falls; Michael (Jan) of Centennial, CO; Mark (Jeanne) of Minneapolis, MN; David (Anne) of Wauwatosa, Bruce (Jean) of McLean, VA and John (Kristin) of Brookfield. Hank was extremely proud of his grandchildren Dan, Monica, Allie, Rob, Liz, Seth, Hannah, Sam, Chris, Peter, Lois, Grace, Laura, Claire, Jack, Erik, Bryan, Maria, Nick and Joe. Hank's life was made richer by stepchildren Richard (Lori) of Roseville, MN; Bill (Jane Marie) of Eden Prairie, MN; Amy (Brian) Sandlass of Pewaukee and Steven (Susan) of Hartford, WI. He adored the Bloomberg grandchildren Peter, Corrin, Aletta, Sara, John, Jacob, Cole and Cooper. He had an incredible laugh and the world's most engaging smile. Hank will be dearly missed, but never forgotten. Complications associated with international documentation and travel have necessitated a change in the previously scheduled visitation and funeral arrangements. The visitation will be from 3 - 8 PM on Friday, November 7, 2008, at the funeral home. The Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, November 8, at St. John Vianney Catholic Church in Brookfield, WI. Committal services will follow the mass, and will be held at St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery, Elm Grove. In lieu of flowers, a memorial in Hank's name to the Boy Scouts of America, Potawatomi Area Council, the Sharon Lynne Wilson Center for the Arts or the UW Foundation ATTN: Health Sciences Learning Center Fund (on behalf of the Urban Family Distance Education Suite of the UW - Madison Medical School) would be greatly appreciated. Whereas, Dr. Urban served in the Army during the Korean Conflict; and✓

Whereas, Dr. Urban married Lois Thurwachter in June 1954, who preceded him in death in 1991 after 37 years of marriage; and✓

Whereas, Dr. Urban married Kathryn Bloomberg in 1992; and✓

Whereas, Dr. Urban held various leadership positions in medicine, including President of the Milwaukee County Medical Society and the Wisconsin Dermatologic Society; and✓

Whereas, Dr. Urban began his political career by serving as a trustee on the Elm Grove village board from 1985 to 1987 and as village president from 1987 to 1989; and✓

Whereas, Dr. Urban was first elected to the Wisconsin Assembly in a September 1989 special election, serving in the 1989 through 2001 sessions; now, therefore, be it
