WHEREAS, the Riverway law was enacted on August 3, 1989, by Wisconsin Act 31, in order to protect and preserve the scenic quality and natural character of the lower Wisconsin River valley and to provide a quality public use recreation area for current and future Wisconsin residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway encompasses nearly 80,000 acres of public and private lands along the final 92 miles of the Wisconsin River; and,

WHEREAS, the unique and innovative new aesthetic protections regulations became effective on October 31, 1989, and were to be administered by a new state agency, the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway Board, with the board holding its inaugural meeting in Muscoda, Wisconsin, on November 1, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway Board has maintained the fragile and delicate balance between protection and preservation of the aesthetic integrity of the Riverway with protection of the rights of landowners and local residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway Board has worked with the Ho-Chunk Nation and other tribal governments, the Wisconsin Historical Society, National Park Service and area residents to protect the many cultural and historical resources of the Riverway; and,

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has worked in partnership with the Riverway Board to acquire lands from willing sellers and to manage public lands for the benefit of the citizens of Wisconsin, as well as to create recreational opportunities for our citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the success of the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway project is due to the cooperation from landowners, residents and local governments from the lower Wisconsin River valley;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Wisconsin State Legislature recognizes the 20th anniversary of the establishment to the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway And commends the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway Board and the citizens and communities of the Lower Wisconsin River valley for their diligent efforts to protect this outstanding natural, scenic and recreational resource for the people of Wisconsin
