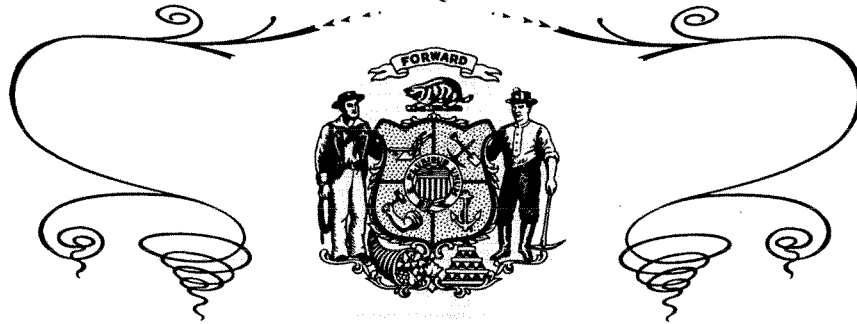

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the Wisconsin legislature proclaim June 12, 13, and 14, 2009, Cesky Den and encourage Wisconsinites to spend that weekend in Hillsboro or Yuba helping to celebrate Wisconsin's Czech heritage and enjoying themselves.



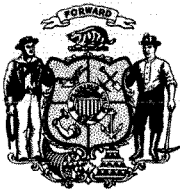
