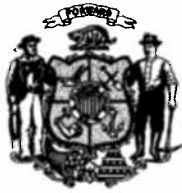
## **Wisconsin Nurses Association 100<sup>th</sup> Celebration**

**Summary:** October 22, 2009 marks the official beginning of a year-long celebration commemorating the 100th Anniversary of the Wisconsin Nurses Association. This historic event is being recognized during a year of observances at both the 2009 and 2010 Annual WNA Convention.

Relating to: the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Wisconsin Nurses Association:

- Celebrates the 94 nurses who attended the first WNA meeting after incorporation at the Pfister Hotel March 31, 1910.
- Celebrates the WNA nurses, all of whom were women and did not have the legal right to vote, who successfully lobbied the legislature for licensure of nurses as a means of protecting the public.
- Honors all the Wisconsin registered nurses serving in the military, past and present, who are continually vigilant and ready to respond when called for a war, conflict, or national emergency.
- Celebrates and applauds the many thousands of Wisconsin nurses who have cared for, nurtured and served the residents of this state, thereby improving the health of Wisconsin communities.
- Recognizes WNA's leadership in providing diverse and creative educational activities to enhance the skills and abilities of professional nurses.
- Recognizes WNA as the leader in assuring the passage of public policy that supports healthy communities; and.
- Most significantly, we proudly recognize the Wisconsin Nurses Association as the voice of registered nurses in this state for the past 100 years.
