WHEREAS, Wisconsin and the nation have an enormous problem with animal overpopulation, a problem that worsens as the economy declines; and


WHEREAS, state and local budget reductions have the potential to add an increased strain on local animal shelter systems, threatening the lives of thousands of animals; and
