2. A draft to change the prohibition on petitioning Congress (I'm guessing this would be a resolution, but I'm not sure).

Whereas, on June 8, 1967, the U.S.S. Liberty, while operating in international

waters in the eastern Mediterranean, was the target of an attack by Israel's war

planes and torpedo boats; and

Whereas, this attack killed 34 members of the U.S.S. Liberty's crew and

wounded 171 other United States personnel on board, in addition to causing

8

extensive damage to the ship; and

Whereas, there continues to be controversy surrounding the attack such that

10

some sailors believe the attack was deliberate and others believe the attack was a

11

mistake by the Israeli military; and

Whereas, aircraft dispatched from aircraft carriers to aid the U.S.S. Liberty

13

were recalled, in violation of United States military law, resulting in 25 of the 34

14

deaths of American servicemen; and
