Wisconsin has a distinguished history in the industrial manufacture of canoes and a proud tradition of canoe restoration and canoe building by private craftsmen that has contributed to the evolution of traditional canoe design; and

Whereas, canoes continue to be employed by recreational boaters, hunters and fishers to the present day and canoeing provides a healthy recreational outlet for many Wisconsin residents and visitors; and
