2009 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 117

March 9, 2010 – Introduced by Representatives Colon, Zepnick, Toles, Pasch, Turner, Kessler, Young and A. Williams, cosponsored by Senators Carpenter, Taylor and Coggs. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1	Relating to: the life and public service of Mary Anne McNulty.
2	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty was a champion for human rights and a
3	passionate woman who represented the near south side of Milwaukee for the 12th
4	Aldermanic District; and
5	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty was a Chicago–raised Irish Catholic who moved
6	to Milwaukee in 1969 when she was recruited to work at the Inner City
7	Redevelopment Project; and
8	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty was involved in politics at the national and local
9	levels and won two terms representing the 12th Aldermanic District in Milwaukee
10	in 1984 and 1988; and
11	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty, after deciding not to seek a third full term in
12	1992, became the director of the South Side Neighborhood Center; and
13	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty spent her whole life being a tireless advocate for
14	the poor and being a strong voice for voter and immigrant rights; and

1	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty fought wholeheartedly for the constituents of
2	the near south side of Milwaukee long after her service as an alderwoman; and
3	Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty passed away on November 6, 2009, at age 61
4	after battling cancer; now, therefore, be it
5	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
6	Wisconsin legislature honor Mary Anne McNulty for her dedication and passion and
7	for tirelessly advocating for the poor and immigrant communities in Milwaukee; and,
8	be it further
9	Resolved, That the members of the Wisconsin legislature express their
10	heartfelt sorrow and deepest sympathies to the family, friends, and colleagues of
11	Mary Anne McNulty; and, be it further
12	Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this resolution
13	to the family of Mary Anne McNulty.
