2009 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 128

April 15, 2010 – Introduced by Representatives Berceau and Kestell, cosponsored by Senators Schultz and Risser. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** commending past and present members of the Friends of the Wisconsin 2 Historical Society on its 60th anniversary. 3 Whereas, in 1950, an enthusiastic and dynamic woman, Ruth DeYoung Kohler, 4 had a strong belief in historic preservation and felt the need to instill interest in the 5 cultural heritage of Wisconsin; and Whereas, Ruth DeYoung Kohler organized the Woman's Auxiliary of the State 6 7 Historical Society of Wisconsin; and 8 Whereas, the Woman's Auxiliary eventually became known under its current 9 name, the Friends of the Wisconsin Historical Society; and 10 Whereas, for the past 60 years, this organization of dedicated volunteers has been a valued partner of the Wisconsin Historical Society in the preservation, 11 12 advancement, and dissemination of information relevant to Wisconsin's proud 13 history; and 14 Whereas, the men and women of this independent volunteer organization have

generously supplemented the activities of the Wisconsin Historical Society at a
