1 **Relating to:** commemorating the 40th Earth Day celebration.

2           Whereas, Gaylord Nelson, a former United States Senator from Wisconsin, was  
3 born and raised in Clear Lake, Wisconsin, in Polk County and is recognized as one  
4 of the leading environmentalists of the 20th century who worked to create a new era  
5 of international awareness of the environment; and

6           Whereas, Gaylord Nelson served in the Wisconsin state senate from 1949 to  
7 1959, as governor of the state of Wisconsin from 1959 to 1963, and in the United  
8 States Senate from 1963 to 1981, truly representing the progressive values learned  
9 as a boy from Clear Lake; and

10           Whereas, Gaylord Nelson created and passed legislation to ban phosphates in  
11 household detergents and to ban the use of dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethane (DDT)  
12 and legislation that created the Apostle Islands National Lakeshore and the St.  
13 Croix Wild and Scenic Riverway and protected other important Wisconsin and  
14 national treasures and worked tirelessly to ensure clean water and clean air for all
