9 scenes helping the Assembly operate smoothly. Debbie will be remembered for her  
10 kind nature, perpetual smile, witty sense of humor, and her love of life, family, and

12       Whereas, Debbie and Stuart also shared a strong commitment to the  
13 revitalization of their Burr Oaks Neighborhood. Stuart served as association  
14 president, and for the last eight years he and Debbie joined fellow residents on  
15 weekly walks to demonstrate the neighborhood's dedication to the betterment of

1 their community. Both Debbie and Stuart enjoyed serving others in their community  
2 and standing up for what they believed was right for their neighborhood and for the  
3 city of Madison; and

4 Whereas, Debbie and Stuart enjoyed spending their free time together,  
5 attending Badger home and bowl games, flying to visit family in New York, hosting  
6 pool parties, taking summer motorcycle trips, and sharing a love of physical fitness.

7 Debbie greatly enjoyed all kinds <sup>of</sup> exercising and was an avid all-season bicyclist.  
8 Stuart sailed, skied, and golfed; and

9 Whereas, both Debbie and Stuart were loyal friends who without hesitation  
10 took the time to listen, provided support to those in need, offered counsel when asked,  
11 and most importantly, had the courage to embrace life and live it fully; now, therefore,
