To create assembly rule 48 (3); relating to: requiring a two-thirds majority vote in the assembly for passage, concurrence, and adoption of proposals that increase the rate of the state sales tax, increase any of the rates of the income tax or franchise tax, or increase a fee.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution requires a two-thirds majority vote for passage, concurrence, and adoption of a proposal to increase the rate of the state sales tax, to increase any of the rates of the income tax or franchise tax, or increase a fee.

Resolved by the assembly, That:

SECTION 1. Assembly rule 48 (3) is created to read:

Assembly Rule 48 (3) All questions of passage, concurrence, and adoption of a proposal to increase the rate of the state sales tax, to increase any of the rates of the income tax, franchise tax are decided by a two–thirds majority vote of a quorum, or increase a fee.
