



## 2009 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 8

April 28, 2009 – Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES.

1 **Relating to:** establishing special orders of business for Wednesday, April 29, 2009.

2 ***Resolved by the assembly, That:***

**SECTION 1. Special order scheduled.** The following proposals shall be special orders of business on Wednesday, April 29, 2009, at the times shown:

- (1) At 7:00 a.m., 2009 Assembly Bill 124, relating to: appellate procedure.
- (2) At 7:01 a.m., 2009 Senate Bill 161, relating to: administration of certain public assistance programs in Milwaukee County, removing county civil service protections from certain employees, required provisions in certain collective bargaining agreements under the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and making an appropriation.
- (3) At 7:02 a.m., 2009 Senate Bill 49, relating to: changing the procedures for filling vacant civil service positions in the city of Milwaukee.
- (4) At 7:03 a.m., 2009 Assembly Bill 172, relating to: requiring instruction in public schools on the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.
- (5) At 7:04 a.m., 2009 Senate Bill 20, relating to: authorizing the circuit court to order a person who engages in discrimination in employment to pay compensatory and punitive damages and a surcharge and making an appropriation.

**SECTION 2. Twelve hour notice.** Consideration of the special order of business established in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall occur at the time shown in that section or 12 hours after adoption of this resolution, whichever is later.
