1 **Relating to:** congratulating Milwaukee Lutheran High School's graduating class of
2 2009.

3 Whereas, Milwaukee Lutheran High School's class of 2009 graduated on
4 Saturday, May 30; and

5 Whereas, the aforementioned class includes three graduates who have been
6 accepted to the service academies for the education and training of commissioned
7 officers of the United States military, to wit, Nikko Ruud, accepted to the U.S. Air
8 Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado; Jonathan Kappel, accepted to the
9 U.S. Naval Academy at Annapolis, Maryland; and Richard J. Wycklendt III,
10 accepted to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point in New York; and

11 Whereas, these academies are highly selective institutions, generally requiring
12 applicants to be nominated by a senator, congressperson, or the vice president of the
13 United States, accepting only a small fraction of those who apply, and requiring
14 successful applicants to demonstrate academic achievement, physical fitness, and
15 good moral character; and
