1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of Sande Robinson.

2           Whereas, Sande Robinson, Director of the Equal Opportunity Program at  
3     Marquette University, began her career at Marquette University in 1974 as a  
4     financial aid counselor in the Equal Opportunity Program, a program which assists  
5     low-income and first-generation college students in obtaining a college degree; and

6           Whereas, Sande Robinson continues to counsel undergraduate students since  
7     she became the director of the Equal Opportunity Program in 1986; and

8           Whereas, Sande Robinson has served as the president of the Wisconsin  
9     Association of Educational Opportunity Program Personnel, and is a member of the  
10    Friends of the Haggerty Museum Board and the Diversity Task Force; and

11          Whereas, Sande Robinson has successfully secured federal funding for the  
12    Equal Opportunity Program throughout its history; and

13          Whereas, she has been active on the national level in presenting models of  
14    support program innovation and has also been a reader of grant applications for the  
15    U.S. Department of Education Student Support Services grant competition; and
