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

Jeff -

Thank you for drafting this, and we understand that with the short deadline that it will be vaguely worded.

Government Efficiency Task Force

The task force would consist of 10 members. The 10 members would be appointed in the following way: 2 by the Assembly Speaker, 2 by the Assembly Minority Leader, 2 by the Senate Majority Leader, 2 by the Senate Minority Leader, and 2 by the Governor. The 10 members must be from a private sector business that is based in Wisconsin. They can not be from any part of the government or any association (what we're getting at is no one from WEAC or WMC).

The mission/goal of the task force would be to find opportunities for Wisconsin's 3120 units of government to collaborate, find efficiencies, and save tax dollars. Specifically, the task force shall look into ways to streamline and pool government services, as well as the potential savings that bulk purchasing could create.

The task force could meet in the Capitol and could be staffed by LFB and/or DOA. State Agencies would have to give up detailed information upon request. No expenses would be paid for by the state.

The task force would be required to report by June 1, 2009 to the Governor and the Legislature with their findings.

This would be an amendment to LRB 1999.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 379, line 25: after that line insert:

SECTION 9157X. Nonstatutory provisions; other?

"(1) GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY TASK FORCE. (a) There is created a Government

Efficiency Task Force consisting of 10 members who shall be appointed as follows:

1. Two members shall be appointed by the speaker of the assembly.
2. Two members shall be appointed by the assembly minority leader.
3. Two members shall be appointed by the senate majority leader.
4. Two members shall be appointed by the senate minority leader.
5. Two members shall be appointed by the governor.

(b) Each member of the task force shall be a representative of a private sector business that is located in this state. No member shall be an employee or agent of any governmental unit or of any association.

(c) The members of the task force shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for personal expenses.

(d) Vacancies in the membership of the task force shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments are made. *remove extra space*

(e) The director of the legislative fiscal bureau shall, upon consultation with the members, call the first meeting of the task force. At its first meeting, the task force shall elect from its membership a chair, vice-chair, and secretary.

f (d) The legislative fiscal bureau shall provide staffing assistance to the task force. The department of administration shall also provide staffing assistance upon request of the task force. Each state agency, as defined in section 20.001 (1) of the statutes, shall provide such information to the task force as may be required to carry out its mission.

g (e) The task force shall find opportunities for the units of government at all levels to collaborate, achieve greater efficiency, and realize savings in tax dollars. In particular, the task force shall examine ways to streamline and pool governmental services, and determine potential savings that could be realized from bulk purchasing.

h (f) The task force shall report its recommendations to the governor and the presiding officer of each house of the legislature no later than June 1, 2009. *4/0*
