



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 64,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 75**

June 11, 2009 – Offered by Representatives KRAMER, VUKMIR, ZIPPERER and VOS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 28, line 5: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 74L.** 16.413 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **16.413 Disclosure of state and school district expenditures. (1)**

5 DEFINITIONS. In this section:

6 (a) “Grant” means a payment made to a person, but does not include any of the
7 following:

- 8 1. Aids to individuals and organizations and local assistance.
- 9 2. Salaries and fringe benefits paid to state employees.
- 10 3. Payments for goods or services pursuant to a contract.

11 (b) “Searchable Internet Web site” means a Web site that allows any person to
12 search for both of the following:

1 1. State aggregate expenditures for state operations by state agency,
2 expenditure category, expenditure amount, and the person to whom the expenditure
3 is made.

4 2. Grants made by state agencies and contracts entered into by state agencies.

5 (c) “State agency” has the meaning given in s. 20.001 (1).

6 (d) “State operations” means all purposes except aids to individuals and
7 organizations and local assistance.

8 **(2) STATE AGENCY EXPENDITURES FOR STATE OPERATIONS.** (a) Beginning on July
9 1, 2011, the department shall ensure that all state agency expenditures for state
10 operations exceeding \$25, including salaries and fringe benefits paid to state agency
11 employees, are available for inspection on a searchable Internet Web site maintained
12 by the department. The department shall also make available for inspection on the
13 searchable Internet Web site the annual salary paid by a state agency to each state
14 employee during the prior 4 years or the during the time that the state employee has
15 been employed by a state agency, whichever is less.

16 (b) The department shall categorize the expenditure information under par. (a)
17 by state agency, expenditure category, expenditure amount, and the person to whom
18 the expenditure is made. If any of the expenditure information may be found on other
19 Web sites, the department shall ensure that the information is accessible through the
20 searchable Internet Web site under par. (a). The department shall also ensure that
21 a person may request and receive electronic updates of expenditure information
22 under par. (a).

23 (c) Beginning with expenditures made on July 1, 2011, state agencies shall
24 provide the department with all expenditure information required under par. (a) no
25 later than 60 days after the expenditure is made. Each state agency shall also

1 include in the expenditure information required under par. (a) the amount of the
2 most recent pay adjustment, performance bonus, or lump sum payment paid to each
3 of its employees. The department may specify the format in which state agencies
4 provide the expenditure information.

5 **(3) STATE AGENCY CONTRACTS AND GRANTS.** (a) Beginning on July 1, 2011, the
6 department shall ensure that all of the following information relating to each grant
7 made by a state agency or contract entered into by a state agency is available for
8 inspection on a searchable Internet Web site maintained by the department:

- 9 1. A copy of the contract and grant award or statement.
- 10 2. The state agency making the grant or entering into the contract.
- 11 3. The name and address of the person receiving the grant or entering into the
12 contract.
- 13 4. The purpose of the grant or contract.
- 14 5. The amount of the grant or the amount the state agency must expend under
15 the contract and the name of the state fund from which the grant is paid or moneys
16 are expended under the contract.

17 (b) Beginning with grants made and contracts entered into by state agencies
18 on July 1, 2011, state agencies shall provide the department with all of the
19 information required under par. (a) no later than 10 days after the state agency
20 makes a grant or enters into a contract. The department may specify the format in
21 which state agencies provide the information. The department shall make the
22 information available on the searchable Internet Web site no later than 30 days after
23 the state agency makes a grant or enters into a contract. The department shall also
24 ensure that a person may request and receive electronic updates of all of the
25 information under par. (a).

1 **(4) SCHOOL DISTRICT EXPENDITURES.** The department shall include in the
2 Internet Web site maintained under this section the information about school district
3 expenditures and contracts reported to it by the department of public instruction
4 under s. 115.32 (4).”.

5 **2.** Page 1233, line 5: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 2255L.** 115.32 of the statutes is created to read:

7 **115.32 Reporting of expenditures relating to school district operations**
8 **and school board contracts and payments. (1) DEFINITIONS.** In this section:

9 (a) “Financial instrument” includes any check, draft, warrant, money order,
10 note, certificate of deposit, letter of credit, bill of exchange, credit or credit card,
11 transaction authorization mechanism, marketable security, and any computer
12 representation of them.

13 (b) “Payment” means a payment made to a person, other than the payment of
14 salaries and fringe benefits for school district employees and payments for goods and
15 services pursuant to a contract.

16 **(2) SCHOOL DISTRICT EXPENDITURES FOR OPERATIONS.** (a) Beginning on July 1,
17 2011, the department shall ensure that each school board reports to the department
18 all school district expenditures for operations exceeding \$25, including salaries and
19 fringe benefits paid to school district employees.

20 (b) The department shall categorize the expenditure information under par. (a)
21 by school district, expenditure category, expenditure amount, and the person to
22 whom the expenditure is made.

23 (c) Beginning with expenditures made on July 1, 2011, each school board shall
24 provide the department with all expenditure information required under par. (a) no

1 later than 60 days after the expenditure is made. Each school board shall also
2 include in the expenditure information required under par. (a) the amount of the
3 most recent pay adjustment, performance bonus, or lump sum paid to each of its
4 employees. The department may specify the format in which school boards provide
5 the expenditure information.

6 **(3) SCHOOL DISTRICT CONTRACTS AND PAYMENTS.** (a) 1. Beginning on July 1, 2011,
7 the department shall ensure that each school board reports to the department all of
8 the following information relating to each payment made by a school board:

9 a. The school board making the payment or entering into the contract.

10 b. The name and address of the person receiving the payment or entering into
11 the contract.

12 c. The purpose of the payment or contract.

13 d. The amount of the payment or the amount the school board must expend
14 under the contract and the name of the fund from which the payment is made or
15 moneys are expended under the contract.

16 2. The report under subd. 1. shall include a copy of the contract or financial
17 instrument used to make the payment.

18 (b) Beginning with payments made and contracts entered into by school boards
19 on July 1, 2011, each school board shall provide the department with all of the
20 information required under par. (a) no later than 10 days after the school board
21 makes a payment or enters into a contract. The department may specify the format
22 in which school boards provide the information.

23 **(4) REPORT TO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION.** The department shall format the
24 information received under subs. (2) and (3) as specified by the department of
25 administration and periodically transmit it to the department of administration for

1 inclusion in the searchable Internet Web site maintained by the department of
2 administration under s. 16.413.”
