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


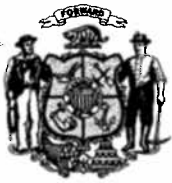
Rep Vos is requesting an amendment that would move the \$1 million appropriation for the unionization of home health care workers to the county welfare fraud appropriation.

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 75

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 1815, line 6: after that line insert:

3 <sup>d</sup>“(11) PHARMACIST REIMBURSEMENT UNDER MEDICAL ASSISTANCE AND SENIOR  
4 CARE. The department of health services may not reduce the reimbursement rate to  
5 pharmacies and pharmacists under the Medical Assistance Program under  
6 subchapter IV of chapter 49 of the statutes or under the program to provide  
7 prescription drug assistance for elderly persons under section 49.688 of the statutes  
8 in the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect.”.
