## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 115, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 75

June 11, 2009 – Offered by Representatives Vos, Gunderson, Huebsch, Kramer, Nygren, Nerison, Newcomer and Kleefisch.

At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

**1.** Page 705, line 13: after that line insert:

**SECTION 1486n.** 66.0903 (13) of the statutes is created to read:

66.0903 (13) Suspension of prevailing wage. The secretary of commerce may suspend the operation of this section upon a finding that the suspension is necessary in light of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary to aid in the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the suspension in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she considers appropriate.".

**2.** Page 720, line 11: after that line insert:

"(11) Suspension of prevailing wage. The secretary of commerce may suspend the operation of this section upon a finding that the suspension is necessary in light of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary to aid in the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the suspension in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she considers appropriate.".

**3.** Page 1171, line 22: after that line insert:

**"Section 2194n.** 103.49 (8) of the statutes is created to read:

103.49 **(8)** Suspension of prevailing wage. The secretary of commerce may suspend the operation of this section upon a finding that the suspension is necessary in light of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary to aid in the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the suspension in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she considers appropriate.".

**4.** Page 1172, line 17: after that line insert:

**"Section 2198n.** 103.50 (9) of the statutes is created to read:

103.50 **(9)** Suspension of prevailing wage. The secretary of commerce may suspend the operation of this section upon a finding that the suspension is necessary in light of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary to aid in the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job

retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the suspension in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she considers appropriate.".

## **5.** Page 1880, line 19: after that line insert:

"(4z) Temporary suspension of prevailing wage. The treatment of sections 66.0903 (13), 66.0904 (11), 103.49 (8), and 103.50 (9) of the statutes first applies to a contract for the erection, construction, repair, remodeling, demolition, or improvement of a project of public works or a publicly funded private construction project entered into, or extended, modified, or renewed, on the effective date of this subsection."

## **6.** Page 1902, line 25: after that line insert:

"(2z) Temporary suspension of prevailing wage. The treatment of sections 66.0903 (13), 103.49 (8), and 103.50 (9) of the statutes takes effect on January 1, 2010.".
