3 **"SECTION 1485n.** 66.0903 (13) of the statutes is created to read:
4 **66.0903 (13) SUSPENSION OF PREVAILING WAGE.** The secretary of commerce may
5 suspend the operation of this section upon a finding that the suspension is necessary
6 in light of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary
7 to aid in the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job
8 retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the
9 operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the
10 suspension in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she
11 considers appropriate."

2 “(11) SUSPENSION OF PREVAILING WAGE. The secretary of commerce may suspend
3 the operation of this section upon a finding that the suspension is necessary in light
4 of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary to aid in
5 the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job retention,
6 and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the operation
7 of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the suspension
8 in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she considers
9 appropriate.”

14 in light of the economic conditions in this state or that the suspension is necessary
15 to aid in the economic development of this state, including to aid in job creation, job
16 retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the
17 operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the

2 retention, and job expansion in this state. If the secretary of commerce suspends the
3 operation of this section, he or she shall publish a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, of the
4 suspension in the official state newspaper and give any other notice that he or she
5 considers appropriate.”.

7 “(4z) TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PREVAILING WAGE. The treatment of sections
8 66.0903 (13), 66.0904 (11), 103.49 (8), and 103.50 (9) of the statutes first applies to
9 a contract for the erection, construction, repair, remodeling, demolition, or
10 improvement of a project of public works or a publicly funded private construction
11 project entered into, or extended, modified, or renewed, on the effective date of this
12 subsection.”.

13 **6.** Page 1902, line 25: after that line insert:

14 “(2z) TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PREVAILING WAGE. The treatment of sections
15 66.0903 (13), 103.49 (8), and 103.50 (9) of the statutes takes effect on January 1,
16 2010.”.
