Joint Finance: Require DOT to award the following grants to the City of Racine under the transportation enhancements grant program during the 2009-11 biennium if it is determined that the projects are eligible for assistance under federal guidelines for the program: (a) a grant of \$400,000 or 80% of the project cost, whichever is less, for streetscaping on State Street from Memorial Drive to La Salle Street; and (b) a grant for \$500,000 or 80% of project costs, whichever is less, for streetscaping on Washington Avenue/7th Street from 9th Street to Main Street.

Joint Finance: Provide \$505,500 in 2010-11 for lift bridge aids to reimburse communities for the estimated costs associated with the operation and maintenance of lift bridges on connecting highways. Repeal statutory references relating to aid payments for each tier of systems for calendar years 2006 and 2007.

Joint Finance: Provide an additional \$241,900 in 2009-10 and \$242,000 in 2010-11 to fully fund the calendar year distribution amounts under the Governor's recommendation. 




