A while back you drafted standalone piece of legislation for Sen. Leibham that would outright ban roundabouts in Kiel, which is exactly what we asked for (LRB-1111/1 now SB 60).

My boss would like to get a budget amendment drafted that would require DOT to delay project ID 4322-08-71, which is the Kiel project, until at least 2012. According to information we received from DOT contracts for this project are currently scheduled for letting in May of 2009. The money saved from delaying this project would be transferred back into the transportation fund. Just incase you need a reference, attached is the correspondence our office has had with the DOT District 3 Administrator Mike Berg on this project.
