

I'm told by Tad Ottman of Sen. Fitzgerald's office that you're the point person on budget amendment requests. I have the following three requests:

1. Delete the nursing home bed assessment increase, and provide a reimbursement rate increase of 3% in each year of the biennium (as provided in Motion 706 in Joint Finance).
2. Retain current law regarding county and municipal levy limits (as provided in Motion 735 in Joint Finance)
3. Retain current law in W-2 as regards Time Limit Changes, Sanctions for Refusal to Participate and Learnfare (essentially the "delete provision" alternatives in LFB Papers 225, 226 & 227); one amendment

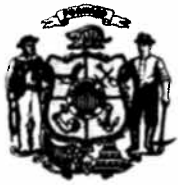

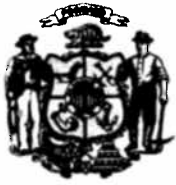
