1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 15: after "credits;" insert "state aid to school districts ~~and to~~
3 ~~public libraries, Medical Assistance, enforcement of motor vehicle safety belt~~
4 ~~violations, modifications to public assistance allocations;"~~

5 2. Page 2, line 17: delete "an appropriation" and substitute "appropriations".

6 3. Page 8, line 12: after that line insert:

7 "SECTION 2p. 20.002 (11) (b) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

8 20.002 (11) (b) 2. Except as provided in subd. 3, the secretary of administration
9 shall limit the total amount of any temporary reallocations to the general fund at any
10 one time during a fiscal year to an amount equal to 5% of the total amounts shown
11 in the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) of appropriations of general purpose revenues,
12 calculated by the secretary as of that time and for that fiscal year. During the

1 2008-09 fiscal year, the amount that may be reallocated under this subdivision may
2 not exceed 7 percent of such revenues."

3 **4.** Page 8, line 16: after that line insert:

4 **SECTION 3g.** 20.255 (2) (p) of the statutes is created to read:

5 20.255 (2) (p) *Federal aids; state allocations.* All federal moneys received, as
6 authorized by the governor, from allocations from the state fiscal stabilization fund
7 that are distributed to school districts as general equalization aid.

8 **SECTION 3p.** 49.175 (1) (j) of the statutes is created to read:

9 49.175 (1) (j) *Aid to families with dependent children overpayments liability.*
10 For payment of liability to the federal government related to overpayments made
11 under the program under s. 49.19, \$2,500,500 in fiscal year 2008-09.

12 **SECTION 3q.** 49.175 (1) (j) of the statutes, as created by 2009 Wisconsin Act ...
13 (this act), is repealed.

14 **SECTION 3t.** 49.175 (1) (ze) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

15 49.175 (1) (ze) 1. 'Kinship care and long-term kinship care assistance.' For the
16 kinship care and long-term kinship care programs under s. 48.57 (3m), (3n), and
17 (3p), \$23,579,800 in each fiscal year 2007-08 and \$23,885,800 in fiscal year
18 2008-09."

19 **5.** Page 30, line 11: after that line insert:

20 "**SECTION 64L.** 347.48 (2m) (gm) of the statutes is amended to read:

21 347.48 (2m) (gm) Notwithstanding s. 349.02, a law enforcement officer may not
22 stop or inspect a vehicle solely to determine compliance with this subsection or sub-
23 (1) or (2) or a local ordinance in conformity with this subsection, sub. (1) or (2) or rules
24 of the department. This paragraph does not limit the authority of a law enforcement

1 officer to issue a citation for a violation of this subsection or sub. (1) or (2) or a local
 2 ordinance in conformity with this subsection, sub. (1) or (2) or rules of the department
 3 observed in the course of a stop or inspection made for other purposes, except that
 4 a A law enforcement officer may not take a person into physical custody solely for
 5 a violation of this subsection or sub. (1) or (2) or a local ordinance in conformity with
 6 this subsection, sub. (1) or (2) or rules of the department.

15 the acts of 2009, the dollar amount is increased by \$12,700,000 for the second fiscal
16 year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect for the purposes for
17 which the appropriation is made.

18 (2f) CORRECTIONS CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS. In the schedule under section
19 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under
20 section 20.410 (1) (ab) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2009, the dollar
21 amount is increased by \$3,000,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium
22 in which this subsection takes effect for the purposes for which the appropriation is
23 made.

24 (3f) SERVICES FOR COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS. In the schedule under section 20.005
25 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under

1 section 20.410 (1) (b) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2009, the dollar amount
2 is increased by \$2,500,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which
3 this subsection takes effect for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.

4 (4f) JUVENILE CORRECTIONS; SERIOUS JUVENILE OFFENDERS. In the schedule under
5 section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of
6 corrections under section 20.410 (3) (cg) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of
7 2009, the dollar amount is increased by \$2,800,000 for the second fiscal year of the
8 fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes effect for the purposes for which the
9 appropriation is made.

10 **SECTION 9222. Fiscal changes; Health Services.**

11 (1f) MEDICAL ASSISTANCE GENERAL PURPOSE REVENUE LAPSE. Notwithstanding
12 section 20.001 (3) (b) of the statutes, there is lapsed to the general fund from the
13 appropriation account of the department of health services under section 20.435 (4)
14 (b) of the statutes, \$306,000,000 in the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in
15 which this subsection takes effect.

16 (2f) MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TRUST FUND APPROPRIATION. In the schedule under
17 section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health
18 services under section 20.435 (4) (w) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2009,
19 the dollar amount is increased by \$62,000,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal
20 biennium in which this subsection takes effect for the purposes for which the
21 appropriation is made.

22 **SECTION 9239. Fiscal changes; Public Instruction.**

23 (1f) AID TO PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEMS; GENERAL FUND. In the schedule under section
24 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of public
25 instruction under section 20.255 (3) (e) of the statutes, the dollar amount is decreased

1 by \$11,297,400 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this
2 subsection takes effect to decrease funding for the purpose for which the
3 appropriation is made.

4 (2f) AID TO PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEMS; UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND. In the schedule
5 under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of
6 public instruction under section 20.255 (3) (qm) of the statutes, the dollar amount is
7 increased by \$11,297,400 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which
8 this subsection takes effect to increase funding for the purpose for which the
9 appropriation is made.”.

11 **“SECTION 9350. Initial applicability; Transportation**

12 (1f) PRIMARY ENFORCEMENT OF SAFETY BELTS. The treatment of section 347.50
13 (2m) (a) of the statutes first applies to violations committed on the effective date of
14 this subsection.”.

15 **8.** Page 43, line 2: after that line insert:

16 “(2f) OVERPAYMENTS LIABILITY ALLOCATION. The repeal of section 49.175 (1) (j) of
17 the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2009.”.

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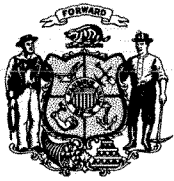

"SECTION 2p. 20.002 (11) (b) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

20.002 (11) (b) 2. Except as provided in subd. 3, the secretary of administration shall limit the total amount of any temporary reallocations to the general fund at any one time during a fiscal year to an amount equal to 5% of the total amounts shown in the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) of appropriations of general purpose revenues, calculated by the secretary as of that time and for that fiscal year. During the 2008-09 fiscal year, the amount that may be reallocated under this subdivision may not exceed 7 percent of such revenues.
