Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law lapses \$291,000,000 in the 2008–09 fiscal year from the state school aid appropriation to the general fund and directs the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to use \$291,000,000 in federal funds received under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) to make payments to school districts in June 2009. This bill lapses an additional \$261,278,000 in school aid to the general fund in the 2008–09 fiscal year and directs DPI to use an additional \$261,278,000 in federal funds received under ARRA to make payments to school districts in June 2009.

The Joint Committee on Finance version of 2009 AB75, the 2009-11 biennial budget bill, spends the \$261,278,000 in federal ARRA funds, designated under this bill, on state school aids in the 2009-11 biennium. Under this bill, AB75 will need to be amended to reflect the expenditure of these ARRA funds instead in 2008-09.
