



2009 SENATE BILL 75

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 14.16 (15) of the statutes; **relating to:** the designation of
2 Korean War Armistice Day.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 14.16 (15) of the statutes is created to read:
4 14.16 **(15)** KOREAN WAR ARMISTICE DAY. To recognize the Wisconsin armed
5 forces members who courageously served during the Korean War, July 27, the date
6 of the military armistice agreement that ended that war, is designated as the
7 “Korean War Armistice Day.” The governor shall issue annually a suitable
8 proclamation for the observance of “Korean War Armistice Day” and request that
9 some portion of the day be used for solemn contemplation on the sacrifices that

2 700 Wisconsin citizens.
