



## 2009 SENATE BILL 311

1     **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
2           of Wisconsin and the Teaching Assistants' Association, AFT, Local 3220,  
3           AFL-CIO, for the 2007-09 biennium, covering employees in the program,  
4           project, and teaching assistants of the University of Wisconsin-Madison and  
5           University of Wisconsin-Extension collective bargaining unit, and authorizing  
6           an expenditure of funds.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

7           **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative  
8           agreement negotiated for the 2007-09 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the  
9           office of state employment relations, and the Teaching Assistants' Association, AFT,  
10          Local 3220, AFL-CIO, covering employees in the program, project, and teaching  
11          assistants of the University of Wisconsin-Madison and University of

1 Wisconsin–Extension collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111  
2 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the program, project, and teaching  
3 assistants of the University of Wisconsin–Madison and University of  
4 Wisconsin–Extension collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended by  
5 the joint committee on employment relations, and authorizes the necessary  
6 expenditure of moneys for implementation from the appropriations made by section  
7 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The  
8 director of the office of state employment relations shall file an official copy of the  
9 agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment  
10 relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the  
11 parties that is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the  
12 legislature under this act.

**SECTION 2. Effective date.**

14 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those  
15 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement  
16 covering employees in the program, project, and teaching assistants of the  
17 University of Wisconsin–Madison and University of Wisconsin–Extension collective  
18 bargaining unit are effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
