1 **AN ACT** *to create* 27.01 (17) of the statutes; **relating to:** the use of golf carts in
2 Governor Tommy G. Thompson Centennial State Park and Peshtigo River
3 State Forest and granting rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 27.01 (17) of the statutes is created to read:
5 27.01 (17) LIMITED GOLF CART USE. The department shall permit the use of golf
6 carts by persons age 16 and over in Governor Tommy G. Thompson Centennial State
7 Park and the Peshtigo River State Forest. The department shall promulgate a rule
8 that specifies when and where golf carts may be used in the state park and the state
9 forest. The rule shall allow golf carts to be used for at least the same hours and in

1 at least the same places as golf carts were used in the state park and the state forest
2 before they were acquired by the state.
