A requirement that an employer grant an unpaid leave of absence to allow an employee to participate in an emergency service operation of the Civil Air Patrol and prohibiting discrimination in employment based on Civil Air Patrol membership

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This legislation would make it illegal for an employer to discriminate against a job applicant or employee on the basis of the person's membership in or participation in the Civil Air Patrol. Additionally for employers with eleven employees or more the employer in most instances would be required to allow an employee who is a Civil Air Patrol member time away from work to participate in search / rescue operations.

Given the fact the Civil Air Patrol has fewer than 1,100 members in Wisconsin the department anticipates passage of this legislation will annually generate no more than an average of one complaint per year alleging disrimination on this basis. An Equal Rights Officer - Senior has the capacity to investigate 132 complaints per year. The department therefore estimates it will need 1/100 of an Equal Rights Officer - Senior position to handle this increased workload. Currently with salary,fringe benefits and supplies/service costs an Equal Rights Officer - Senior costs the department \$78,036 per year. The department would also need to revise its informational brochures and publications to publicize this change in the law at a one-time cost of \$2,000. The Equal Rights Division can not absorb these increased costs.

Local Costs:

The costs to local government for this legislation would arise when employees who are Civil Air Patrol members would need to leave work for a search or rescue mission and the employer would have to replace that worker for the missed time. If replacing the worker by assigning other workers additional work hours that resulted in overtime premium pay for those workers there would be additional costs to the employer. The department anticipates these additional costs would be minor. In 2008 the Civil Air Patrol participated in 19 search or rescue missions statewide. Typically these missions were of short duration [4-6 hours]and only involved 6-8 persons.
